## LEARNING CENTER

During this month at the Sneha Foundation **Learning Center**, children learned through animated videos, making concepts easier to understand with the help of the digital board. Difficult topics were clearly taught with examples, which improved their learning ability. Through this method, children's revision and understanding became stronger.



## N. P. MEHTA PRIMARY SCHOOL REPORT

During this month, various activities were conducted at **N. P. Mehta Primary School**, run by **Sneha Foundation**. Kindergarten children participated in activities such as the “**invisible eye**” magic experiment, changing the color of a magical flower, mind games, paper pasting work, and identifying vegetables. Similarly, primary school students engaged in craft work, science experiments, making Christmas trees, and creating shapes of insects and animals using leaves.

To support the development of different abilities among kindergarten children according to their age and capacity, activities like the “**invisible eye**” magic flower color-changing experiment were conducted using turmeric, lemon, and soap powder as part of a mind-game activity.

Along with this, to help children recognize vegetables, various vegetables were shown to them and identification activities were carried out. Throughout the month, children were taught through different activities to enhance their understanding and learning.



## OVERALL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

### ● BIRTH ANNIVERSARY OF DR. BABASAHEB AMBEDKAR

On 6 December 2025, an inspirational program was organized at Sneha Foundation on the occasion of the birth anniversary of **Babasaheb Ambedkar**. The main objective of this program was to explain Babasaheb's life, his thoughts, and his contributions to society to the children in simple and easy language.

Children were informed that Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar was the chief architect of the Indian Constitution and that he struggled throughout his life to ensure equal rights for everyone. Despite facing discrimination from childhood, he made education his strongest weapon and earned high academic degrees. He gave society the great message of "Educate, Organize, and Agitate," which continues to inspire everyone even today.

During the program, children were encouraged to ask questions, and their curiosity was satisfied through simple examples. This activity aimed to develop values such as equality, interest in education, and good morals among children.



## ● MODEL OF THE SOLAR SYSTEM

As part of holistic development activities, an educational activity on the **solar system** was organized for children at Sneha Foundation on **10 December 2025**. The main objective of this activity was to develop scientific understanding, encourage imagination, and make the learning process enjoyable.

Under this activity, children created a beautiful and creative model of the solar system. While making the model, all the planets such as the Sun, Moon, Mercury, Mars, and Earth were shown in proper sequence. Children were given the opportunity to make the model using colored paper, thermocol balls, cardboard, paints, and other simple materials.

After completing the model, children were explained in simple terms that the Sun is the center of the solar system and that all planets revolve around the Sun in their respective orbits. They were also informed about why life is possible on Earth, how day and night occur, and the special features of each planet.

Thus, this activity on the solar system organized at Sneha Foundation proved to be educational, interesting, and useful for the children.



## ● IDENTIFICATION OF ANGLES USING CHARTS

On **20 December 2025**, as part of a holistic development activity at Sneha Foundation, children were taught about **angles**, an important topic in mathematics, especially the **types of angles**. At the beginning of the activity, the teacher explained in simple and clear language what an angle is, how it is formed, and where we can see angles in our daily life. Examples were shown on the board to help children easily understand the concept.

Children were introduced to different types of angles such as acute angle, right angle, obtuse angle, straight angle, and complete angle. The degree measure of each type of angle was explained with examples.

Children were given chart papers and prepared attractive charts showing different types of angles based on their understanding and imagination. Some children used colored pencils and sketch pens to make appealing drawings, while others labeled the angles with names and definitions.

This activity helped enhance children's creativity, understanding, and self-confidence.



## ● **POCSO ACT AND TRAFFIC AWARENESS PROGRAM**

On **25 December 2025**, a significant awareness program was organized at Sneha Foundation by the District Legal Services Authority, Bhavnagar. The main objective of this program was to spread legal awareness among children and provide them with information about their safety.

During the program, children were educated about traffic awareness. They were taught the importance of following traffic rules while walking on the road, the significance of traffic signals, why helmets and seat belts are necessary, and how to remain cautious while driving vehicles or crossing the road. All information was explained in simple language.

Children were also informed about the POCSO Act. They were made aware that any inappropriate touch or misbehavior by anyone is a crime. They were clearly instructed that if such an incident occurs, they should immediately inform their parents, teachers, or any trusted person without fear. Special emphasis was placed on the fact that children have the right to protect their own bodies.

Guidance was also given on precautions to prevent kidnapping. Children were advised not to talk to strangers, not to accept sweets or gifts, to remain alert while going outside, and to immediately inform a nearby adult or the police in case of any suspicious situation.

### ● CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION

On 25 December 2025, **Christmas** was joyfully celebrated at Sneha Foundation. On this occasion, children were informed in a simple and meaningful manner about the importance, traditions, and message of Christmas. They were explained that Christmas conveys the message of love, peace, sharing, and unity.

Children participated in various Christmas-themed craft activities. They were taught to make Christmas trees, stars, Santa Claus figures, and more. They took part in these activities with great enthusiasm and interest. During the celebration, a sense of happiness, excitement, and participation was clearly visible among the children.

Sneha Foundation will continue to organize such festival celebrations to promote cultural understanding, love, and mutual cooperation among children.



## ● BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION

## ADOLESCENCE

Under the **Adolescence** Project operated by Sneha Foundation, **sanitary pads** were distributed to a total of **139** girls by **Dr. Hardikbhai Khatri**. Due to the regular implementation of this project, all the girls associated with the foundation are now using sanitary pads, which has led to a reduction in infection-related diseases in women and increased awareness among the girls.

## ● **INTERNSHIP**

A total of **16** students studying sociology at **Valiya Arts and Commerce College** came to Sneha Foundation for an internship. The main objective of this internship was to provide students with practical experience related to their sociological studies.

Sneha Foundation works in various ways for economically backward sections of society, and information about these activities was explained to the students in simple language.

During the orientation, students were guided about the organization's work, objectives, and various areas of social service. They were also sent for a survey in the Khedut Vas area, where they collected information about children whose education was incomplete, the economic condition of families, living conditions, employment, and social problems.

Through this survey, students gained practical exposure to sociology and got the opportunity to closely understand the real conditions of society. This survey work carried out under the guidance of Sneha Foundation proved to be very useful and experiential for the students and inspired them to work in the field of social service in the future.
