## ● National Science Day

On **28 February 2026**, **National Science Day** was celebrated with great enthusiasm at **Sneha Foundation** and **N. P. Mehta Primary School**. The main objective of the program was to develop scientific curiosity, innovative thinking, and an experimental approach among the students.

On this occasion, students prepared and presented various scientific models, such as Electric Chilly Cutter, Magnetic Levitation, Chemical Processes, and other science-based experiments useful in daily life. Each student confidently presented their model and explained its working method and significance.

Parents of the students were also present during the program. They felt proud and delighted to witness their children's presentations and achievements. At the same time, the event also provided them with an opportunity to learn new scientific concepts and ideas.



## ● EDUCATIONAL TOUR

Due to the regular implementation of this project, all the girls associated with the foundation are now using sanitary pads, which has led to a reduction in infection-related diseases in women and increased awareness among the girls.
