● WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY

● WORLD DAY AGAINST CHILD LABOUR

● PLANET BLUE TEAM INTRODUCES CHILDREN TO THE WORLD OF BIRDS

● WATER CONSERVATION AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

During this, the local people were made aware of the importance of water and were motivated to use it economically.

During the program, detailed information about rainwater harvesting was provided. It was explained in a simple manner how rainwater collected from rooftops can be used for household purposes and stored for future use. In addition, through a PPT, the internship students also provided information about various methods of saving water, the importance of water conservation, and water literacy. At the end of the program, everyone was motivated not to waste water and to actively contribute towards water conservation.





ADOLESCENCE PROJECT

Under the **Adolescence Project** being implemented by the Foundation, **Dr. Hardikbhai Khatri** distributed **sanitary pads** to a total of **142** girls. Due to the regular implementation of this project, all the girls associated with the institution have now started using sanitary pads, which has helped reduce diseases among women and increased awareness among the girls.

● **SANITARY PADS DISTRIBUTION**
