## OVERALL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

### ● **GURU NANAK JAYANTI CELEBRATION**

On **4 November 2025**, Guru Nanak Jayanti was celebrated with great devotion and joy at Sneha Foundation. The programme began with a prayer and remembrance of Guru Nanak Dev Ji. Children were given interesting information about the life of Guru Nanak Dev Ji and how he taught the path of humanity, equality, kindness, and truth.

The children were explained how Guru Nanak Ji broke down social barriers and gave the message of unity for all mankind. They were also taught about ancient history such as how the Guru tradition began, what the social and religious conditions of that time were, and how Guru Nanak Dev Ji's teachings brought positive change to society.



## ● **OBSERVATION ACTIVITY**

On **22 November 2025**, a special observation activity was organized at Sneha Foundation for the holistic development of children. The main aim of this activity was to increase the children's knowledge, develop their ability to observe things closely, and build curiosity towards nature.

Under this activity, children were shown various types of grains and pulses such as wheat, rice, moong, tuvar, chana, rajma, urad, etc. They were allowed to hold them and observe them closely. Teachers explained the names, colours, sizes, shapes, and uses of each grain and pulse in simple language.



## ● IDENTIFICATION OF ACIDS AND BASES

On 29 November 2025, under the holistic development activities, an interesting session on identifying acids and bases was conducted at Sneha Foundation. Children were taught how to use litmus paper to identify whether a substance is acidic or basic.

During the activity, the teacher first explained what acids and bases are, their characteristics, and how litmus paper works. Then, through practical demonstrations, children observed how the colour of litmus paper changes when tested with various household substances.





# FESTIVAL CELEBRATIONS

## ● DEV DIWALI CELEBRATION

On 5 November 2025, Dev Diwali was joyfully celebrated at Sneha Foundation on the sacred day of Kartik Sud Purnima. Children were informed about the significance of Dev Diwali.

They were told that **Dev Diwali**, also known as **Kartik Purnima**, is an important Hindu festival. According to belief, on this day the Gods descend from heaven and celebrate by lighting lamps on the banks of the Ganga. Hence, it is known as the Diwali of the Gods. On this day, “Ganga Snan”, lamp donation, and charity hold special importance.

Along with this, the children were also told about the divine incident of Lord Shri Krishna. It was explained that on this very day, Lord Krishna left Dwarka and arrived in Dakor as Thakorji. This divine event has now completed 869 years and has entered its 870th year. The celebration should include bhajans, kirtans, aarti, and prasad distribution.



# TRIBUTE PROGRAMME

## ● A TRIBUTE TO LATE MALTIBEN GILL

On the Remembrance Day of **Late Maltiben Gill**, a tribute program was organized at Sneha Foundation. The children and staff of the Foundation collectively remembered Maltiben for her dedication, selfless service, and contributions to social reform.

The children expressed their feelings through a heartfelt prayer showing respect towards Maltiben. The programme started with lighting a lamp, followed by two minutes of silence to honour her sacred memory.

The greatness of Maltiben's personality and her values were beautifully reflected in the presentation of the children.



## ADOLESCENCE

Under the **Adolescence** Project operated by Sneha Foundation, **sanitary pads** were distributed to a total of **139** girls by **Dr. Hardikbhai Khatri**. Due to the regular implementation of this project, all the girls associated with the foundation are now using sanitary pads, which has led to a reduction in infection-related diseases in women and increased awareness among the girls.

## SEWING CLASSES

Sneha Foundation has started sewing classes to make economically disadvantaged women of Khedutvas area self-dependent. This initiative aims to open new employment opportunities, increase skills, and enhance household income for women from the underprivileged community.

Through this training, women are taught various practical skills including basic stitching, machine handling, measurement, cutting, designing, fall-Pico work, blouse stitching, pants, shirts, churidar, and kids' wear. To ensure no financial burden, all required materials are provided by the Foundation. The main aim of the training is to make women self-reliant and independent.

The Foundation believes that when a woman becomes empowered, her entire family becomes empowered. These sewing classes are an important step in that direction.
