At Sneha Foundation's **Learning Centre**, half-yearly examinations were conducted for children from Standard **1** to **9**. ## N. P. MEHTA PRIMARY SCHOOL REPORT

At N.P. Mehta Primary School, managed by Sneha Foundation, students from Nemisharaniya School organized a "Joy of Giving" program. During the school's term-end examinations for Class 1 to 5, a Diwali celebration program was also organized, which included the distribution of sweets and snacks.

### ● CELEBRATION OF GANDHI JAYANTI

### ● INFORMATION ABOUT BANK

On 8<sup>th</sup> October 2025, under **the overall development activity**, Sneha Foundation organized a program **related to banks** for the children.

During the program, children were given detailed information about what banks are, their importance in daily life, and how banks help in keeping money safe.

Children were also taught about saving accounts, passbooks, ATMs, and debit cards. Teachers showed them how to fill a withdrawal form and what details are necessary while withdrawing money from the bank.

The children participated with great interest and asked many questions to satisfy their curiosity. The goal of the program was to increase financial awareness among children, develop self-reliance, and inspire them to become responsible citizens in the future.



## ● **HANDICRAFT ACTIVITY**

On **13<sup>th</sup> October 2025**, as part of overall development activities and the Diwali festival, a special **handicraft** session was organized for the children. On this occasion, children got a chance to show their creativity. They made various decorative items such as colorful lamps, torans, flower garlands, paper lamps, and Diwali cards.

Teachers guided the children on how to use household and eco-friendly materials to make beautiful decorative items. All the children participated enthusiastically and displayed the items they made with their own hands. Through this activity, children developed creativity, concentration, teamwork, and respect for traditional festivals.
